
This letter is a follow-up to our letter dated November 13, 2007. I was delivered yet another "Affidavit of Criminal Acts" from your organization, this one relating to Commissioner Dahlstedt, which appears to be virtually identical to "Affidavit of Criminal Acts" pertaining to Commissioner Munks that was addressed by our November 13, 2007 letter. With respect to the latest "Affidavit of Criminal Acts," please review our letter dated November 13, 2007.

You seem confused about the function of the Prosecuting Attorney Civil Division. We are charged with representing the legal interests of Skagit County, including the defense of civil lawsuits.

Judging by your extensive postings on the gorskagit.com website, you keep up on the local press and are thus fully apprised of the fact that this issue now centers on PUD's concerns about funding and liability. With that in mind, it is not entirely clear why you continue to harangue our office with various quasi-legal documents pertaining to this issue. The Prosecuting Attorney's Office has no opinion on the issue of fluoride as a County policy matter.

The Board of Health has made its decision on fluoride, and that decision is final. If you feel you have rights that have been violated and require redress (we are aware of none), please feel free to file a lawsuit. Without waiving any claims or defenses, this office will accept service of process to the extent you comport with relevant civil rules. Absent that, it appears we have no further obligation to communicate with you or otherwise respond to your claims.
